Luke 24:34,36, John 20:19-20, Acts 1:22, 1 Corinthians 15:6

### 10) Is it important that Jesus was resurrected? Why?

1 Corinthians 15:12-19

### 11) As a Christian, how has my life been affected by Jesus’ death, burial and resurrection?

Galatians 2:20
